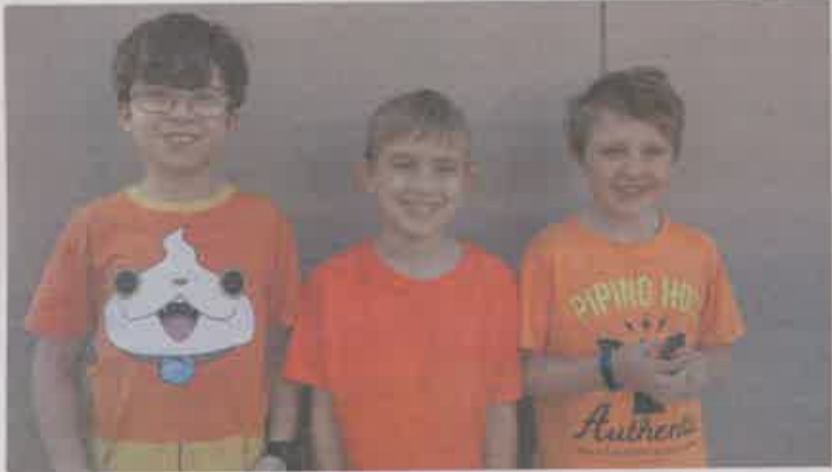
Their aim was to raise funds to donate for the Red Cross in aid of the recent Townsville Flood Crisis.

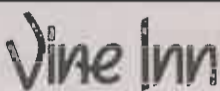

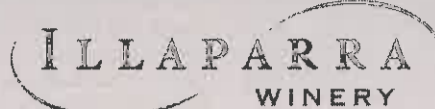

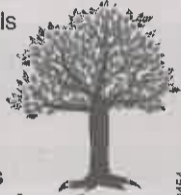
