Too bad for heaven

Is anyone too bad to go to Heaven? Most people seem to think there must be some around who are - like Hitler or Stalin or many other tyrants through history.

Is there anything worse than being too bad? There is, it is believing you are not too bad.

There is hope for the person who believes he is too bad because it was for their sake that Jesus came.

Listen to His words - "I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

The person who believes he is not too bad, has no need of Jesus.

Jesus referred to these when He said, "Many will come to Me and say... "Have we not done many good deeds", but I will say to them, Depart from Me, I never knew you."

Jesus is only interested in people who believe they are too bad. He did not come, as He said, "to call the righteous."

The Bible tells us there is good reason for that. There are none that are righteous. Romans chapter 3 declares, "There is none righteous, no not one."

So again I ask - "Is anyone too bad to go to Heaven?"

We had better wake up to ourselves and say "Yes! I am."

We are in a sorry mess; we cannot change what we are, but Jesus is the Physician who can save us. What we are unable to do, Jesus can do.

As the Bible says, "He who knew no sin, was made to be sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God in Him." Even now, He is calling you to trust Him.

"Come unto Me all ye who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."
