LITTLE CORELLAS



The Barossa Council will soon commence its annual program to deter and disperse large flocks of Little Corellas in affected areas.

Little Corellas are unprotected and flock together in large numbers in some populated areas throughout summer and autumn, causing widespread damage and nuisance to the community.

The program will involve the use of orange flashing lights on vehicles and spot-lights during periods of low ambient light; together with starting pistols, bird scaring cartridges and live ammunition in appropriate areas to unsettle and disperse the flocks.

SA Police are aware of the program and will be kept informed.

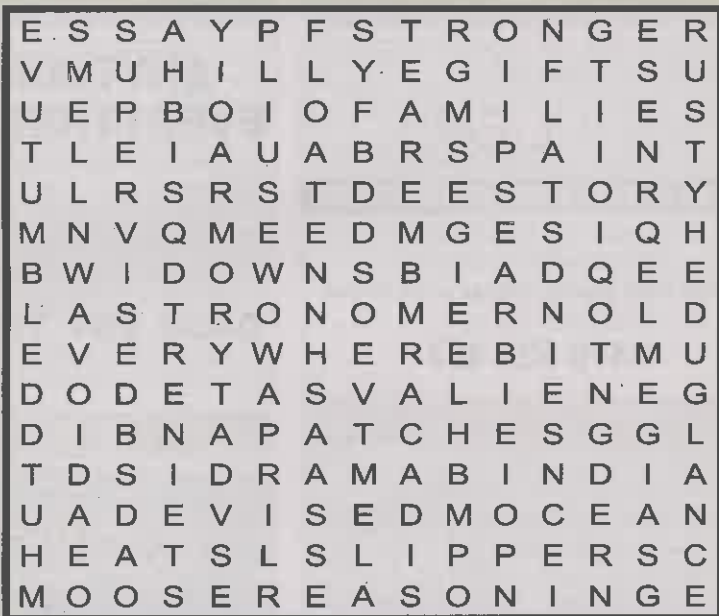

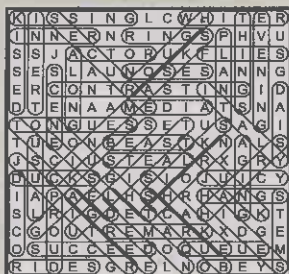
