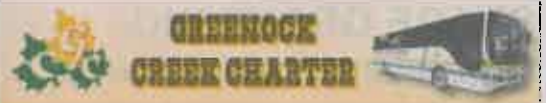

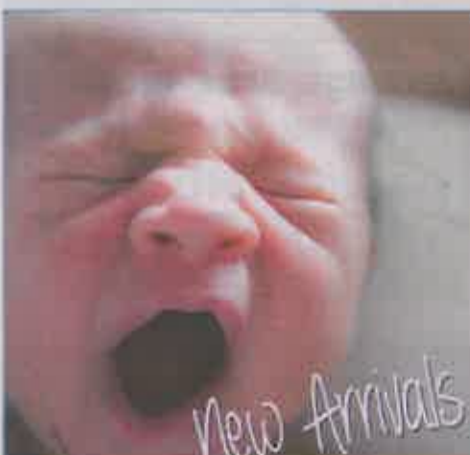

Genetically Modified (GM) Crops consultation



Legislation has been passed by the SA Government to lift the Genetically Modified (GM) moratorium to allow GM crops to be grown on mainland South Australia under changes to the Genetically Modified Crops Management Act 2004. Councils may apply to the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development to retain 'Non-GM crop area' status.

The Barossa Council is seeking the views of community, business and industry on potential trade and marketing impacts of GM crops and whether there is support in making an application to be designated as a 'Non-GM crop area'.

Council invites submissions via a survey available at Council's principal office 43-51 Tanunda Road, Nuriootpa and Council branch offices or online at yoursay.barossa.sa.gov.au. Submissions are to be received by 5.00pm, 19 August 2020.

Road Closure Walker Place Official Opening Event

TOWN OF GAWLER TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS,
6am to 6pm on Monday 3 August 2020 in Walker Place, Gawler.



I, Sam Dilena, holding the position of Manager, Infrastructure & Engineering Services, Town of Gawler, pursuant to Clause F of the Notice to Council to use Traffic Control Devices and to Close Roads and Grant Exemptions for Events letter from the Minister delegating to the Council the power conferred on the Minister under Section 33(1) of the Road Traffic Act to declare that an event that is to take place on a road or road related area is an event to which Section 33 of the Act applies and Council resolution made on the 24 January 2017 sub-delegating said power to the holder of the office of Chief Executive Officer to make an order directing either or both of the following:

- That specified roads (being roads on which the event is to be held or roads that, in the opinion of the Council, should be closed for the purposes of the event) be closed to traffic for a specified period; and
- That persons taking part in the event be exempted, in relation to the specified roads, from the duty to observe the Australian Road Rules specified in Clause F of the Notice, subject to the conditions in Clause F of the Notice.

Authorise the Town of Gawler to close Walker Place as indicated on the above traffic management plan in order to conduct the Walker Place Official Opening Event. Walker Place between Julian Terrace and Murray Street will be closed to traffic from 6am to 6pm on Monday 3 August 2020.
