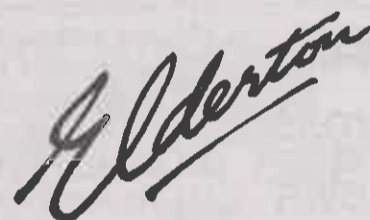

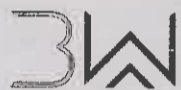

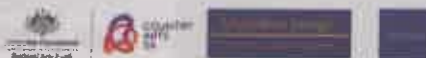

Genetically Modified Crops Consultation

Legislation has been passed by the SA Government to lift the Genetically Modified (GM) crop moratorium to allow GM crops to be grown on mainland South Australia under changes to the Genetically Modified Crops Management Act, 2004.

Councils may apply to the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development to retain 'Non-GM crop area' status.
