LLL Australia appoints new CEO

The Lutheran Laypeople's League (LLL) has appointed Mr Ross Smith as its new Chief Executive Officer.

In 2019, the LLL became the first charitable financial institution in Australia to be licensed as an Authorised Deposit-taking Institution (ADI) regulated under the Banking Act and by APRA.

Mr Smith will replace Mr Allen Kupke, who is retiring, as only the fifth person to head the organisation since its inception in 1921.

It is expected Mr Smith will commence his role as CEO in October.

Mr Smith is currently CEO of the Anglican School's Corporation in NSW, which oversees

14,500 students.

He is also Chairman of the Glebe Administration Board, which oversees a \$220 million investment fund, and was previously Chairman of the Sydney Diocesan Secretariat.

He comes from a strong finance and management background, with his career shaped by extensive experience in corporate restructuring and work in mergers and acquisitions in Australia, Silicon Valley and London.

His credentials include financial sector roles at KPMG, PwC and McGrath Nicol.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO DEVELOPMENT

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Neoen Australia Pty Ltd (as previously sponsored for the purposes of 'public infrastructure' by the Department for Energy and Mining under Section 49 of the Development Act 1993) for the staged construction of the Goyder South Hybrid Renewable Energy Facility. Development Application: 422/V009/20.

The main development comprises: (a) windfarm (up to 163 turbines to a maximum tip height of 240m) with a capacity of up to 1200MW; (b) solar farm (across two sites) with a capacity of up to 600MW over 3000 hectares; and (c) energy storage facility with a capacity of up to 900MW/1,800MWh (2 hours).

Associated works include electricity infrastructure (e.g. substations, access roads, underground cabling and overhead transmission lines), permanent operations and maintenance compounds, and meteorological masts. Temporary construction compounds for both wind and solar components, including concrete batching plants, storage and laydown areas, will be established during the construction phase.

The project area encompasses the ranges and plains between the Barrier Highway and the Goyder Highway, over approximately 30,000 hectares and various land parcels, spanning a distance of 27km from the south and south-west of Burra (starting 5km from the town centre) to north of Robertstown. Full details of the project area are contained in the application documentation.

The development site is located within the Primary Production Zone of the Goyder Council Development Plan (Consolidated 24 November 2016).

The application may be examined during normal office hours at the office of the State Commission Assessment Panel, Level 5, 50 Flinders Street, Adelaide and the office of the Regional Council of Goyder, 1 Market Street, Burra.
