The bad news is that under current Government plans, Job Keeper and Job
Seeker are being reduced and both will be phased out early next year.
The good news is that in preparation for a busy 2021 vintage Tarac are now
taking applications for vintage casual roles. We are seeking applications
from people who hold at a minimum a High Risk forklift license and a SA
driver's license for all positions but in addition we are looking for:

- 4 qualified and experienced Front End Loader Drivers (HR license would
be a bonus)
- 2 bonds people to work across several aspects of our Samuel Road site
