Helping to eradicate polio worldwide

Rotary Clubs of Kapunda, Barossa Valley, and Barossa and Districts are hosting the Rotary Polio Ute Relay on November 13 in Kapunda; November 14 in Tanunda; and November 15 in Nuriootpa.

The Rotary International District 9510, which extends across most of South Australia and into the Northern Territory and western New South Wales and Victoria, has launched the 2020 Rotary Polio Ute Relay.

The ute relay aims to act as catalyst to increase public awareness about Rotary and its connection to polio eradication, and will raise significant funds for the End Polio Now campaign.

Rotary celebrates 100 years in Australia in 2021 and is conducting a baton relay to celebrate.

The R100 Baton Relay aims to connect all Rotary Clubs across Australia and NZ with their communities.

The ute relay will carry the baton with it.

Rotary District 9510 kickstarted its Polio Ute Relay on World Polio Day, October 24, in Alice Springs, NT.

The relay will travel throughout Rotary District 9510 with staging posts throughout SA and into Western NSW, winding up in Adelaide, SA, on December 19.

The ute will become a gleaming beacon for the End Polio Now campaign as it travels around.

The 2020 Rotary Polio Ute Relay comes at an important time in the fight to eradicate polio, which would be only the second human disease to be eradicated.

There is no cure for polio, but for as little as 60 cents worth of oral vaccine, a child can be protected from the disease for life.

Rotary International made polio eradication its top priority in 1985.

The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation matches every \$1 Rotary commits to polio eradication 2-to-1, raising up to US\$150 million per year.

Rotary has contributed more than \$2 billion to end polio and its members have logged countless volunteer hours to help immunize more than two billion children in 122 countries.
