## Angaston Chemists

One chemist of special note was Dr R. M. Hardy who, in the early 1920s had a house and shop on the bottom corner of South Terrace and Murray Street, (opposite the Reserve).

He later moved up to the shop at 64 Murray Street (what is now Jenny's Sewing) which had a basement where he also sold ice creams and had a soda fountain, which became very popular.

Dr Hardy's fame came in the form of a formula he created for indigestion powder, which, in due course was marketed throughout the eastern states as well as in South Australia for over 50 years.

It was very effective and popular till the name and formula was bought by an opposition pharmaceutical and they took the powder off the chemist shelves in South Australia.

As an interesting aside, an empty vintage Hardy tin was seen being offered on the internet for \$25.

The next chemist at 64 Murray Street was A. M. Steinthal and in 1930, he was dispensing a popular Lemon Balm which he claimed was good for insomnia, stress, anxiety and guess what else?...yes.... indigestion .

In the period 1910 to 1931 there was a famous Holloway's Ointment which was good for sore breasts, sore heads, bad legs and a cure for gout and rheumatism and was

manufactured in London and came in a very small jar. The asking price today, for the very small white ceramic "empty" Holloways Ointment jar with fancy black print is \$119 on the internet.

Mr H. H. ( Bill ) Young was our next chemist at number 64 and he expanded the range of goods available besides the ointments and pills, to also offer Healing radios, repairs, batteries and service.

He sold cameras and film and took in the customer's box Brownie camera film roll of 12 or 24 photos for developing which were then forwarded to Kodak, for a waiting time of a week or more for the developed photos to come back.

Bill was a keen photographer himself and could often be seen around the town at special events with his camera.

In 1958 he gave out little note books with calendar on the back in appreciation of his customers of regularity ( could that have affected his Laxette sales? )

Bill was quiet, always the well dressed gentleman, and quite involved in a number of town organisations as well as cricket and football.

Number 64 Murray Streets' next and last chemist tenant was Peter Wescombe in 1969.

Peter moved out five years later to the newly built chemist shop next to butcher Schulz.

Mr. A. O. Schmidt had a chemist shop at 53 Murray Street from 1907 to 1914. (site of the current Angaston Post Office).
