Light or darkness

We can't have anything more diametrically opposite than light and darkness.

It therefore must come as a stark reality that the Bible says we all belong to one or the other.

The difference is marked by our view of God.

They who are in darkness always misunderstand what God is doing.

In fact they misunderstand everything about God.

They especially misunderstand His kindness. When things go well, they assume God is pleased with them. When it works the other way, they accuse God as unfair.

In the 1930's, the German Wehrmacht had movements dedicated to assassinate Adolph Hitler.

He foiled many attempts, and he took it as a sign of God's pleasure on him.

Hitler once said in great arrogance, "God did not permit me to die until my purpose is fulfilled."

Saddam Hussein was another one. He also escaped assassination attempts, and made similar conclusions.

Kapunda Mine Historic Site - Proposed In-Situ Recovery Test

Council has received a request from Environmental Copper Recovery Pty. Ltd. (ECR) to access a location in the south-eastern part of the Kapunda Mine Historic Site (Mine Site) (near the intersection of Perry Road and East Terrace) to undertake a test of its 'In-Situ Recovery' (ISR) mining method. ISR is a method of metal recovery involving the use of 'environmentally benign lixiviants' (leaching agents).

The test proposed by ECR is associated with a Commonwealth-funded project commenced in July 2018, which has also involved the University of Adelaide and the CSIRO.

The State Government, through the Department of Energy and Mining, is responsible for assessment and any approval of the proposed mining activity (test), however as landowner Council is required to consider whether it will permit access to the Mine Site for this purpose.

In accordance with the Community Land Management Plan for the Mine Site, Council is seeking community feedback on this proposal. Details are available for inspection until Wednesday, 23 December 2020 at Council's principal office 93 Main Street Kapunda or via Council's website www.light.sa.gov.au

Written submissions on the proposal will be accepted until 5.00pm on Wednesday, 23 December 2020.

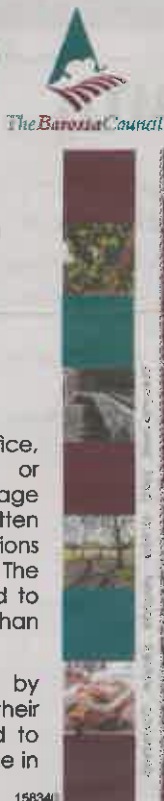
