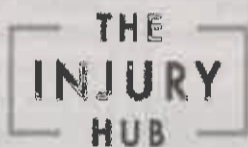

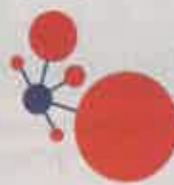

Give Us Proof



Someone says, "give us proof, and we will believe."

The fact is, you have all the proof you need. And you have all the proof you are ever going to get. That proof is the Bible itself.

Jesus said, "If they do not believe the Bible, they will not believe if someone was to rise from the dead" (Luke 16:27-31).

There is no book like the Bible, and there is no Saviour like Jesus Christ. He is the only religious figure in history who was prophesied to come.

There are numerous prophecies written hundreds of years before His coming describing His character, His mission and His rejection and death. But more importantly, His resurrection and power and glory.

Take some time and begin to read the Bible for yourself.

Begin at the gospel of John. The Bible is its own proof. To the sincere seeker, the Bible is what we call, "self-evidencing". You don't light a candle to see the sun. The proof of the Bible is so overwhelming that the Bible itself says, "you are without excuse". There will be a day of judgment, and on that day those who have refused to face up to the "proof" will be without excuse.

This is not written as a threat, this is written as a plea. What do you do with proof? You can behave like a criminal, and try to hide the proof, or try to hide yourself from it. But that is only temporary.

The Bible can only be explained as the Word of God.

How else could you have one book written by 40 different authors over 1,400 years, yet still retain one theme and purpose throughout?

God Himself says, "Day and night I have stretched out My hands to a disobedient people," but one day, those outstretched hands will be withdrawn.

Don't ignore the proof. It calls for a response of faith and commitment. Jesus said, "He who hears My Word, and believes in Him Who sent Me, has everlasting life.

He will not come into condemnation, but is passed from death into life." Is that not a wonderful thing to believe?

Could there be any greater reward for simply responding to the proof?

The very act of faith, says Jesus, is its own proof. It indicates a new birth into everlasting life. Don't turn away - listen to Him.

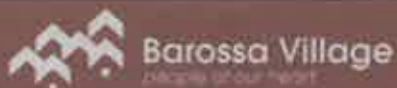

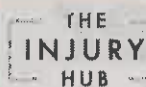

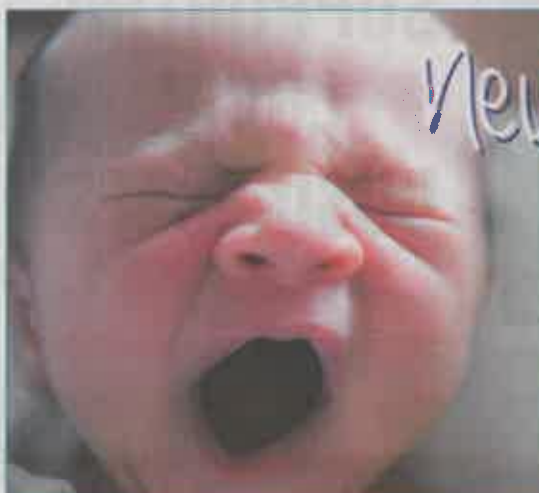
