Everyone of us are going to die.

From the oldest to the youngest, our future is totally predictable.

It is death and the grave. From the fittest to the laziest, from the poorest to the richest, we all must die.

It doesn't matter how many escapes from death we have, it will eventually come.

A popular song a few years ago said, "My future's so bright I have to wear shades".

You could sing that if you like, but you would be kidding yourself.

We are going to die. What we don't know is when, or where or how, but we do know it will come.

## That old Pepper Tree

Locate the ruins of an old pioneer farm house or barn and most likely there will be the scraggy remains of an old Pepper tree very nearby, whilst they were not the most attractive tree, they gave good shade.

The Pepper Tree or Pepper Corn Tree, is a native to northern South America and into Mexico and is actually identified as a weed ( *Scinus Areira* ) It was introduced To Australia and listed in a Victorian nursery catalogue in the 1870's and 1880's.

It was widely planted in homestead gardens, backyards and on farming properties by the early settlers around Angaston as well as throughout South Australia. Very often seen down by the chook house or milking shed but mainly it was near to shed or house. It was

introduced to the dry outback gardens and farms for its shade and drought resistant tendency, certainly not for its good looks but for its spreading limbs that gave good shade.

The Pepper tree grew to a height of 12 meters and had drooping fern like leaves which are aromatic when crushed, a large spreading hardy tree quite drought resistant and ideal for our Australian climate.

A mature tree had two other important qualities, number one being that it was quite resistant to fire and could readily regenerate after a fire. Secondly the tree was also is known to have properties that act as a repellent for some insects.

The trunk and limbs were covered in rough bark and the trees timber was of little value and the spreading branches and slight toxicity did not attract the attention of any wildlife. But otherwise it was a clever introduction to the farm by the farmers of the day.
