Turner's Hill

I have written some 40 tales since the Covid 19 virus struck.

After I found I had time on my hands I did some renovating then got back to what I like doing, that is writing and sketching.

In all those memories that have been published I have written in the third person and one fine beautiful blonde lady said I should be writing "my" (Barry Chinner story).

Well here I am writing of my personal experiences and even using that single letter word "I"

It begins with my knowledge and association with a local butcher, Mr Perc Turner who was a purveyor of fine meats.

In my teen years I would head out of town with my .22 rifle and shoot rabbits for our kitchen table.

With the surplus skinned and dressed rabbits I would door knock and sell around town.

The rabbit skins I would stretch over triangles of fencing wire to dry in the sun and then take to Mr Turner's butcher shop.

He would pay me for the skins and send them off along with the hides of beasts he had slaughtered to Adelaide.

Turner's owned the hill to the north behind their shop (now

Birthstones) and in the horse and cart days, they allowed for a fee, an overnight stay for the traveller's horse when booked in at the hotel.

In my early teens I often walked over Turner's hill looking for mushrooms or just enjoying the elevated sights of Angaston from the very top of the hill.

I do have a print of a George French Angas painting which he painted from the Turner hill behind my house looking towards Angas Park (Nuriootpa), c 1845.

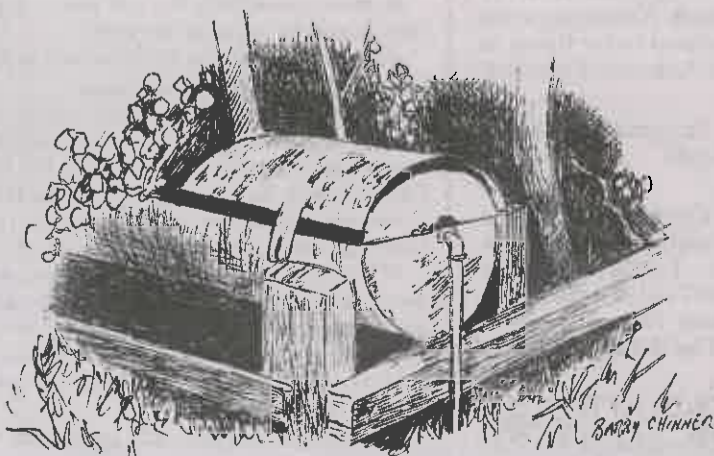
Turner's hill fronted onto the Penrice road for some hundred yards up from the Penrice Road bridge and not far up, in 1951a house was built for the Cement Works manager.

This house was bought by me in 1973 and has been my home to this day.

I have a fine view down through the gully and remember the time before the trees got so tall, I could watch cars travelling along the Nuriootpa / Tanunda Road.

Moving to more recent times and there are now lots of houses along Penrice Road, on either side, right up to Penrice.

It is also of very recent times that I gained a new neighbour, her house, as is mine, both built on Turner's hill, a special lady friend who insists I should write in the "first person". Just for you Alicia... I have!
