NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT TO DEVELOPMENT

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Green Power Investment Pty Ltd (as previously sponsored for the purposes of public infrastructure by the Department for Energy and Mining under Section 49 of the *Development Act 1993*) for consent to increase the capacity of a previously approved battery energy storage system from 50MW/MWH to 200MW/MWH and the inclusion of up to 5MW in solar panels. Development Number: 313/V025/21.

The proposed development includes: the installation of additional containerised batteries, inverters, roof structures to shield the the containers, and solar panels on the roof structures. Associated works include: the construction of hardstand and laydown areas, stormwater drainage works, fencing, and energy network connection (to an adjacent substation).

The subject land is situated at Templers Road, Templers (being QP44, D90124; CT 6235/173), adjacent the existing SAPN substation.

The development site is located within the Primary Production Zone and General Farming Policy Area 3 of the Light Regional Council Development Plan (Consolidated on 8 December 2016).

The application may be examined during normal office hours at the office of the State Commission Assessment Panel (SCAP), Level 5, 50 Flinders Street and at the office of Light Regional Council's Planning & Development Services, 12 Hanson Street, Freeling.


