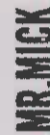

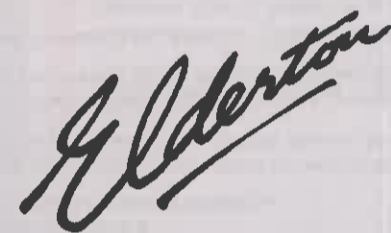

By-Law 1 of 2021 - Permits and Penalties

To provide for a permit system, set penalties for breaches of by-laws, provide for certain matters pertaining to liability and evidence, set regulatory requirements, clarify the construction of Council's by-laws and for related purposes.

By-Law 2 of 2021 - Movable Signs

To protect visual amenity and public safety on roads and footpaths by setting standards for moveable signs and regulating their placement in a manner which recognises the advertising needs of businesses.

By-Law 3 of 2021 - Roads

For the management, control and regulation of certain activities on public roads in the Council area.

By-Law 4 of 2021 - Local Government Land

For the management and regulation of the use of and access to local government land under the control of Council, including the prohibition and regulation of certain activities.

By-Law 5 of 2021 - Dogs

For the management and control of dogs within the Council area and to limit the number of dogs kept on premises.

By-Law 6 of 2021 - Cats

A by-law to limit the number of cats that can be kept on premises in certain circumstances.

By-Law 7 of 2021 - Waste Management

To regulate the collection and removal of waste streams from premises, to protect amenity, for regulating the management of Council property; for the comfort, safety and convenience of the community.
