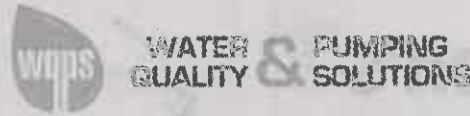

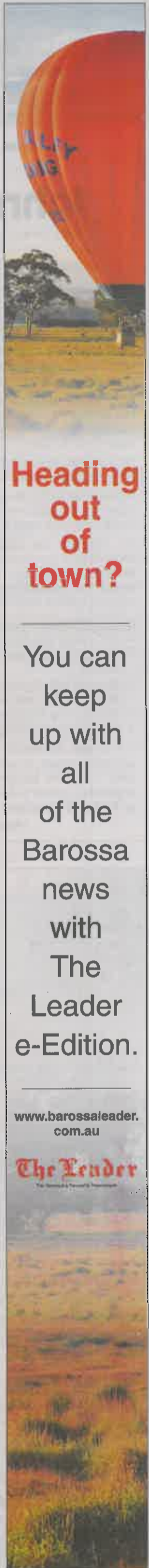

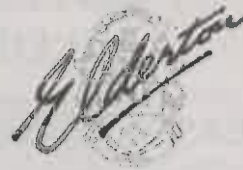

Dog and Cat Management Plan 2022-2027

Adelaide Plains Council invites submissions in relation to a proposed Dog and Cat Management Plan (the Plan) for 2022 to 2027.

The Plan builds upon the previous plan and has been prepared in accordance with Section 26A of the Dog and Cat Management Act 1995 (the Act) which requires all councils in South Australia to develop a plan of management relating to dogs and cats within their area.

The purpose of the Plan is to guide Council's management of dogs and cats for the next five years (2022-2027). In particular the document:

- Promotes responsible dog and cat ownership
- Provides for the welfare and safety of dogs and cats
- Works to ensure public safety
- Harnesses the benefits of dog and cat ownership
- Fulfils statutory requirements and local laws.

The Plan's actions cover education, encouragement, and enforcement, with an intent to foster attitudes and behaviours which promote responsible dog and cat ownership.
