Committee unchanged for Angaston and Penrice Historical Society

Angaston & Penrice Historical Society held their Annual General Meeting on October 26 when all officers were returned.

President, Bill Gransbury; Vice President, Rebecca Bolton; Secretary, Anthony Schubert; Treasurer, Ian Williamson; Auditor, Wilf Kubisch; Records/Photographic Keeper, Anne Batten; Recruitment Officer, Viv Fiebiger.

Committee: Leo Leggett, Anne Batten, Robert Broad, Bill and Elizabeth Sibley, Jo Zander and Jan McKenzie.

In his president's report, Bill Gransbury touched on the success of the Barossa History Fair held in May as well as both the Angaston Railway and the Centenary of Angaston Hospital exhibitions staged at the History Centre during the year.

Topics including the Angaston Show, the St. John Cadet Camps at Angaston from 1951-2016 and First Nations people in the Barossa are hoped to be future displays at the History Centre.

Also stated in Bill's report was the major community project currently being undertaken to restore the twenty-five pounder cannon in the Memorial Reserve, thanks to Robert Broad, Leo Leggett and Ian Williamson.

The AGM was an ideal opportunity to note that it had been twenty-five years since the late Paul Mariani re-opened the Doddridge Blacksmith Shop.

It remains an operating tourist attraction today thanks to the support of the community and many dedicated volunteers.

A 'Save The Blacksmith Shop' signboard was then unveiled which will soon be proudly placed in the museum.

The sign acknowledges all of the donors who contributed to the 2016 'Save the Blacksmith' project which became possible when Kerrie Kiefel, widow of Paul Mariani, offered the site to the Angaston and Penrice Historical Society.

It reads 'On October 7, 2016 a community meeting chaired by Bill Gransbury was held in the Old Union Chapel, where a 'Save The Blacksmith Shop' business plan was presented by Ian Williamson.

Following the adoption of this plan, \$169,300 was raised in three months. This enabled the purchase of the blacksmith shop that had since October 25, 1996 been reopened and revived by Paul Mariani.

The money raised also enabled the construction of the Angaston Museum at the rear of the property. The Museum was opened by Hardy Doddridge's grandson, John Batten on May 23, 2018.

Following the formal proceedings Don Ross, Secretary of the Barossa Valley Archives and Historical Trust, discussed the history of that organisation. Don was President of the Trust from 1973-86 and has had his current role since 1986.

He touched on how the Trust started in 1963 mainly due to the efforts of the late Roger Teusner, along with Peter Heuzenroeder and Dr Colin Reuter.

The Trust moved to its present site in 1972 at the former Tanunda Post Office which is now their museum.

The organisation continues to digitalise old films and photographs and add various items to their museum.

Don also spoke about his early home life and was presented with a gift before those present enjoyed supper and fellowship.
