\$150m remote roads program

GUIDELINES are now available and applications open for the Federal Government's Remote Roads Upgrade Pilot Program, paving the way for upgrades to some of Australia's forgotten roads.

The government said it had committed \$150 million for upgrades to unsealed roads throughout remote Australia, many of which had not been worked on since the Great Depression in the 1930s.

Federal Member for Barker Tony Pasin said councils across the electorate could now apply to have projects that were important to them funded and delivered.

Mr Pasin said the funding would improve quality of life in regional and remote areas by increasing accessibility to regional communities and delivering essential infrastructure.

"The government recognises the costs of upgrading rural and regional roads are often prohibitive for local governments," Mr Pasin said.

"To ensure these import-

ant projects are funded, the Government will be funding up to 80 per cent of the approved projects to deliver improved key road networks and road safety.

"I look forward to working closely with local councils to secure funding for important road upgrades."

Unsealed or degraded roads 20 kilometres or longer with a low safety rating are eligible for funding under the program.

The project must not have previously received funding under another program, or received significant investment in the last five years.

Mr Pasin said the government was continuing to invest in the future of regional and remote Australia.

"Our government is delivering the projects that regional Australians need to live and get ahead," Mr Pasin said.

"Remote roads are out of sight and out of mind for most Australians, but that doesn't make them any less important to our supply chains and the freight operators and regional Australians who rely on them.

"We're investing in these upgrades because they will keep Australians who choose to live in remote areas safe on their local roads, towns and communities connected, and freight moving.

"These upgrades will give mums and dads confidence they can get their children to school when it rains, or complete a trip to the supermarket to purchase the products their household needs.

"Improving remote roads will also support our regional businesses, ensuring their products continue to reach supermarkets and ports and keeping them connected with international markets.

"Regional Australians deserve the same services and opportunities as people living in our capital cities and that's why we're investing in the projects that are important to people living off the beaten track."

Allowing super for home deposits 'to ignite new boom'

WITH the rampaging property market just starting to calm, a group of the nation's leading property economists is warning that allowing Australians to use their superannuation savings on a house deposit would reignite a price explosion.

A new McKell Institute report, 'Mortgaging Our Future', has used sophisticated modelling to project the effect on the housing market should Australians be given access to their super to use on a home deposit, as advocated by a range of federal government MPs, including Tim Wilson.

The new report finds the Tim Wilson proposal would add nearly \$69,000 to the price of the average house in Sydney, \$108,000 in Melbourne, and an astounding \$159,000 in Adelaide

The report also finds that Australians who chose to invest in a house deposit instead of keeping their money invested in super would retire worse off, because the average returns

in a super fund are superior to the average growth in a home.

The McKell Institute's executive director, Michael Buckland, said the report was a sobering reminder of what was at stake.

"Homes have already become unaffordable for millions of Australians, and allowing super balances to be spent on house deposits would make things so much worse," he said

"The Tim Wilson proposal would pour fuel on the fire of our housing market at exactly the time when we are desperate for a little calm

"Super-for-housing would mean first-home buyers handing their hard-earned retirement savings to existing property owners when they would be better off investing them in super.

"Young Australians need their retirement savings quarantined and compounding. Using these savings to fuel yet another housing market feeding frenzy would be policy madness."
